**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING**  
Proposed Amendments to Rabies Control Rules and Regulations for  
Greene County

Please take note that the Greene County Board of Health proposes to repeal the current Rabies Control Rules and Regulations for Greene County and replace them with recently DPH adopted Chapter 511-2-7 Rules for Rabies Control pursuant to its authority under O.C.G.A. § 31-3-6 and O.C.G.A. § 31-19.

The current rabies regulations are outdated. The pace of scientific research into rabies and improvements in best practices in rabies control is such that the public and county health departments are better served by regulations which permit the Department to update its rabies control guidance through revisions to its “Rabies Control Manual” rather than through rulemaking.

All comments received will be presented to the Board at its next regularly scheduled meeting. This notice is issued pursuant to the Clarke County Board of Health By-Laws.
