NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING
Proposed Amendments to Madison County Board of Health Rules and Regulations for On-Site Sewage Management Systems

Please take note that the Madison County Board of Health proposes to amend The Rules and Regulations for Georgia DPH On-Site Sewage Management Systems adopted August 14, 2014 as authorized by Georgia statute in OCGA 31-3-5(b)(2) to establish minimum lot sizes.

The current lot size adopted by the Madison County Board of Health August 10, 2000 does not incorporate section M of the sewage manual which has been used to define useable soil area in the adopted lot size. Readopting the current policies will provide a concise lot size ordinance.

The Madison County Board of Health solicits your comments for this action. Comments can be made in writing by mail to the Madison County Environmental Health Office to be received prior to the public hearing date, or orally at a hearing before a Hearing Officer 12:30-1:00 p.m. on Thursday August 9, 2018, in the Madison County Health Department Conference Room located at 1424 Highway 98 West, Danielsville, GA 30633
