NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING
Proposed Amendments to Rabies Control Rules and Regulations for
Jackson County

Please take note that the Jackson County Board of Health proposes to repeal the current Rabies Control Rules and Regulations for Jackson County and replace them with recently DPH adopted Chapter 511-2-7 Rules for Rabies Control pursuant to its authority under O.C.G.A. § 31-3-6 and O.C.G.A. § 31-19.

The current rabies regulations are outdated. The pace of scientific research into rabies and improvements in best practices in rabies control is such that the public and county health departments are better served by regulations which permit the Department to update its rabies control guidance through revisions to its “Rabies Control Manual” rather than through rulemaking.

The Jackson County Board of Health solicits your comments for this action. Comments can be made in writing by mail to the Jackson County Environmental Health Office to be received prior to the public hearing date, or orally at a hearing before a Hearing Officer 11:30 p.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday August 14, 2018, in the Commerce Health Department Conference Room located 623 South Elm Street, Commerce, GA 30529
