PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

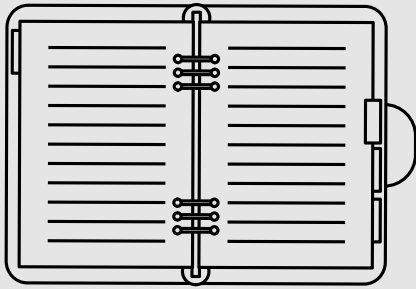


All employees need wear personal protective equipment when available and necessary to the job of the employee. Disposable materials and supplies should be used as much as is practicable.

DISCONTINUE WALK-INS

Services can only be offered on an appointment basis. Walk-in customers should not be allowed. Customers that do make an appointment should wait in the car until their service provider is ready.



SANITATION

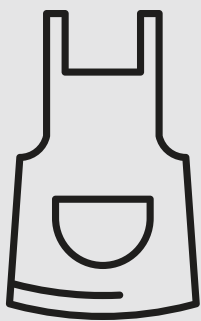


All equipment, chairs, and tables used by employees and customers should be sanitized between each customer and use.

LIMIT EMPLOYEES

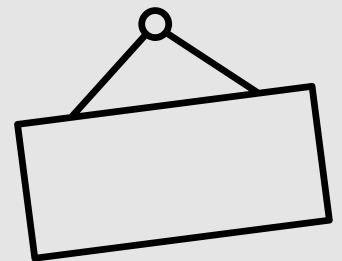
No more than 50% of the normal number of employees that provide services can be in the business at one time. Each provider is also only allowed one client at a time.



POST EYE LEVEL SIGNS

A eye level sign must be posted at the entrance saying that no one with a fever or symptoms of COVID-19 may enter.

REDESIGN WORK AREAS

Stagger the use of workstations or space workstations more than ten (10) feet apart, This should be done according to whichever option is practicable given the facility's configuration but one must be utilized.
